Subject to the following conditions:

(a) the poisons named above shall be stored at the premises located at -

FIRST FLOOR
6 MONTEREY ROAD
DANDENONG SOUTH VIC 3175

(b) and subsequent (see attachment)

This permit shall remain in force until 01/10/2021 next, unless renewed, cancelled, suspended or revoked in accordance with the provisions of the Act or Regulations thereunder.

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- (b) The acquisition, storage, use, recording and destruction of the poisons or controlled substances which are the subject of this permit must be strictly in accordance with the *Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981* and the Regulations made under the Act.

The fact that the Department of Health and Human Services has issued this permit must not be construed as meaning that the Department endorses any of the permit holder's activities involving the usage of scheduled substances obtained using the permit.

- (c) (i) To confirm compliance with the requirements of Victorian Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances legislation, or to propose changes to elements of this permit, the holder of this permit must complete the relevant change or review form, available from the Victorian Medicines and Poisons Regulation website.
- (iii) The following person(s) have been delegated responsibility by the permit holder for overseeing compliance with legislation -

- (iii) When any above named person ceases employment with the permit holder or transfers to other responsibilities, the permit holder must, as soon as practicably, notify the Department of Health and Human Services about the change, by completing the change or review form, available from the Victorian Medicines and Poisons Regulation website.
- (d) The permit holder must maintain true and accurate records showing full details of all transactions involving all poisons or controlled substances covered by this permit that are obtained, used, or disposed of. These records must be retained for a period of three years and produced in writing, on demand to an authorised officer of the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (e) The permit holder must ensure that any loss, theft or misappropriation of a poison or controlled substance is reported to Victoria Police, and to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (f) The permit holder must ensure that the maximum quantity of the following substance(s) held at any one time does not exceed the corresponding quantity:

Cannabis and tetrahydrocannabinols	5 kilograms
All other Schedule 8 substances	300 grams

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- (g) The permit holder must take all reasonable steps to ensure that-
- i) the listed regulated Schedule 7 poisons are stored, held, or used on the premises to which this permit relates, except when required to be used offsite as part of the regular business activities of the permit holder; and
 - ii) the listed regulated Schedule 7 poisons are stored in a lockable storage facility with access restricted and
 - iii) the storage facility is kept locked at all times except when it is necessary to open it to carry out an essential operation in connection with the poisons stored therein.
