Subject to the following conditions:

(a) the poisons named above shall be stored at the premises located at -

108-112 MERRINDALE DRIVE  
KILSYTH VIC 3137

(b) and subsequent (see attachment)

This permit shall remain in force until 01/02/2019 next, unless renewed, cancelled, suspended or revoked in accordance with the provisions of the Act or Regulations thereunder.

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- (b) The purchase, obtaining, storage, recording and use of the poisons or controlled substances named in the permit must be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the *Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances Act 1981* and the Regulations made thereunder.
- (c) (i) The holder of this permit must confirm its compliance with the requirements of Victorian Drugs, Poisons and Controlled Substances legislation by completing a poisons control plan, and forwarding the plan to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (ii) Any proposed changes to the plan must be forwarded to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (iii) The following person has been delegated responsibility by the permit holder for overseeing compliance with legislation -
- Jason M HALL**
- (iv) When the above named person ceases employment with the permit holder or transfers to other responsibilities, the permit holder must immediately notify the Department of Health and Human Services in writing of the change and nominate (on the appropriate form) another person to assume that responsibility.
- (d) The permit holder must maintain true and accurate records showing full details of all poisons or controlled substances covered by this permit that are obtained, used, or disposed of. These records must be retained for a period of three years and produced, in writing, on demand to an authorised officer of the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (e) The permit holder must ensure that any loss, theft or misappropriation of any poison or controlled substance covered by this permit is reported forthwith to the police, and in writing to the Department of Health and Human Services.
- (f) A person named in condition (c) must ensure that the maximum quantity of all Schedule 8 poisons does not exceed 300 gram and that the maximum quantity of all Schedule 9 poisons does not exceed 10 gram.
- (g) A person named in condition (c) must take all reasonable steps to ensure that -
- (i) the Listed Regulated Schedule 7 poisons are stored, held, or used on the premises to which this permit relates, except when required to be used off site as part of the regular business activities of the permit holder; and
- (ii) the Listed Regulated Schedule 7 poisons are stored in a lockable storage facility with access restricted; and

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- (iii) the storage facility is kept locked at all times except when it is necessary to open it to carry out an essential operation in connection with the poisons stored therein.
